- Bible & pen
- Sleeping bag & fitted sheet to cover the mattress
- Pillow & pyjamas
- 4 days worth of clothes (please refer to guidelines below)
- One pair of old clothes

- A beach towel, bath towel & toiletries

camp theme

When some of the Jews began to believe on Him, early in His ministry, Christ said to them:

If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed - John 8:31

He recognised that many wanted to follow Him *and* keep their traditions, habits and previous ways of life. In Acts 11:26 we learn that the believers at Antioch were being referred to as little Christs, or Christians. Today *anyone* who attends any sort of church is referred to as a Christian, however are we really following Him and enjoying the freedom that comes with that? Our teenCAMP 2024 theme is Made Free - when I know and obey the truth of God's Word, then I am free.
